The Fresno County Department of Public Works and Planning is in the process of updating the Housing Element of the General Plan. The Housing Element is being updated for the 4th and 5th cycle planning periods. For the fifth cycle planning period update (2015-2023), Fresno County and 12 of the 15 cities in the county are preparing a Multi-Jurisdictional Housing Element with assistance from the Fresno Council of Governments (FCOG). The Multi-Jurisdictional Housing Element is intended to address countywide housing issues and needs more effectively at the regional and local levels. The public review drafts have been prepared and will be presented to the Board of Supervisors on July 14, 2015.

On July 14, 2015 the Fresno County Board of Supervisors will hold a study session to review the Housing Element public review draft update for the 4th and 5th cycle planning periods. The purpose of the study session is for staff and the Housing Element Update consultant to present an overview of the draft Housing Element for both cycles and receive input from the Board of Supervisors and the public before submitting the documents to the State Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) for the State-mandated 60-day review for compliance with State law.
